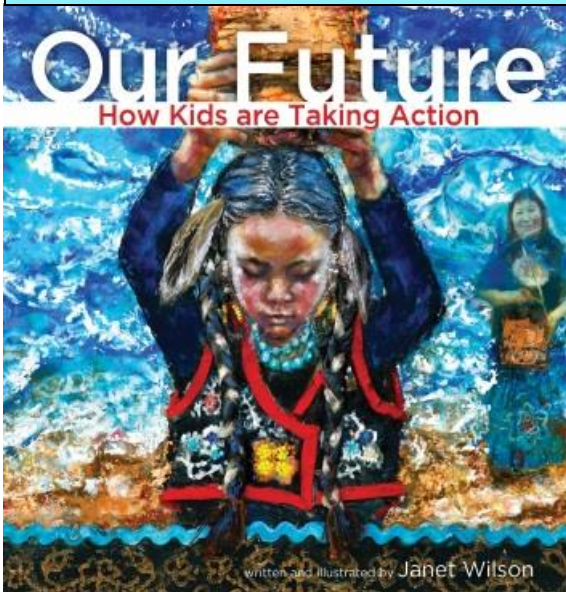


JANET WILSON: AUTHOR, ILLUSTRATOR, SPEAKER

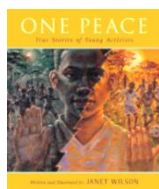
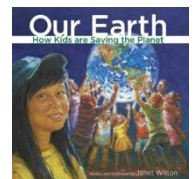
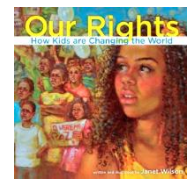
